EMERSON BRIDGE PARK RULES

- 1) All fees must be paid before the camping unit will be permitted to stay in the Park.
- 2) Registration fees are: \$30.00 per unit for power sites, non power sites are \$20.00 per camper unit and \$15.00 per tent.
- 3) No littering.
- 4) No destruction or removal of vegetation from the park.
- 5) No discharging of fireworks, projectiles or explosives of any type.
- 6) No alcoholic beverages are permitted except in designated campsites.
- 7) Fires must be attended at all times.
- 8) Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- 9) It is the pet owner's responsibility to clean up after their pets.
- 10) No Off-Highway Vehicles (ATV'S).
- 11) Quiet times are between 11:00p.m. and 7:00a.m.
- 12) Loud, raucous or obscene behavior will not be tolerated.
